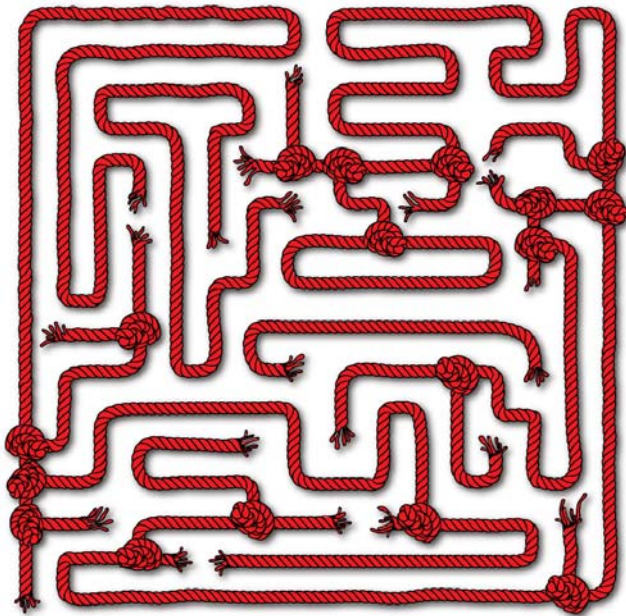

Texas is an open primary state. Every person who votes Republican in the primary is a Party member until 12/31 of the following year.

A political party, BCRP cannot charge a membership fee. However, donations are gratefully accepted. Funds support the GOP office, Federal candidate signs, voter outreach & contact such as the 2022 Voter Guide. The BCRP does not endorse in primary races.

A GPAC*, LPRW has annual membership dues. Its fundraisers support GOP candidates, trainings, and various community projects. LPRW does not endorse in primary races.

LPRW has directly donated to candidates on the ballot in Bastrop County, more than \$10,000 in the past 5 years. LPRW co-authored & split the \$7,000 cost of the 2022 Voter Guide with the Bastrop County Republican Party.

A GPAC*, the GOP Club is a social club that sponsors "Pints & Politics". Dinners open to all Bastrop County Republicans. Members receive dinner discounts.
